Norin Landing Park was completed in 2019 and is one of two boat launches in Otsego on the beautiful Mississippi River. This park's amenities include a boat landing, fishing pier, and river viewing areas. There is also a park shelter which includes picnic tables and signage that highlight the historical background of the area. For avid anglers, Norin Landing boasts one of the best small bass fishing areas in the state. Besides fishing, park users can enjoy observing the local wildlife that the river supports, especially trumpeter swans and eagles.
